- The City Offices, Municipal Court, Public Library, and Landfill Gate will be closed on Monday February 19, 2024, for President's Day Holiday.
- The next City Council meeting will be on Monday, February 12, 2024, in the Council Room at City Hall beginning at 6:00 p.m. A list of the agenda items will be posted on the front glass at City Hall on Friday, February 9, 2024.
- As a reminder, if you keep livestock within the city limits you are required to have a permit. Annual permits expired on December 31, 2023, so please contact the city to have your permit renewed. Also, all dogs and cats must have/be current on rabies vaccination and be registered with the city. Contact City Hall for information.
- Did you know the City recycles cardboard? Green dumpsters are through out the city, with many being behind businesses. Or, you can take your cardboard to the Memphis recycle center, located at the entrance of the city landfill. Need more information please contact the City Hall.
- Currently, customers with delinquent bills will only receive one notice on their door of payment due, with a disconnect date if payment is not made. The water department allows delinquent customers to make payment arrangements to bring their account current. All accounts with delinquent balances for more than two consecutive months must be paid in full to avoid disconnection. As a reminder, you can pay your water bill online at www.ThePaymentGroup.com. We also offer draft payments from any bank account. If you are interested, a form is available at the water office. You can drop your water bill payment in the fire hydrant drop box by the front door of City Hall. If you have any issues or questions about your water bill, please contact City Hall immediately.

- The city is dedicated to cleaning up the town. The landfill is **FREE** to Memphis residents and businesses except for roofing materials, tires, appliances containing freon and demolition debris. There is a charge for those items and prices can be acquired by calling (806)259-3001. Landfill hours are Monday Saturday 8:00 am 5:00 pm and closed from 12:00 pm 1:00 pm for lunch. We also want to remind citizens that the alley behind your property is the homeowners' responsibility to mow and keep clean, that includes debris, tree limbs, and grass clippings. Please do not use the dumpsters to throw away grass clippings. We appreciate the City's effort in cleaning up our town.
