

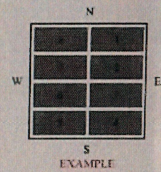

Most plots contain 8 spaces. These are numbered 1 through 8, beginning with 1 in the NorthEast corner, going South and then turning North to 8 in the NorthWest corner. When you find the name in the book it will be followed by numbers like B-595-1. This means that the person is buried in Birch section number 595 in space #1 which is the most Northeast grave in Birch section.

This cemetery is made up of 4 sections. Aspen, Birch, Cedar & Dogwood. The South half of Cedar and the SouthWest part of Dogwood is the oldest part of our cemetery dating back to the 1880s.

The South half of Cedar was mostly migrant workers that died while in Memphis working in the crops and the harvest. In the very SouthWest corner of Dogwood is what is known as "Potter's Field", or burials that were done by the county. Our information on this part of the cemetery is very limited.
